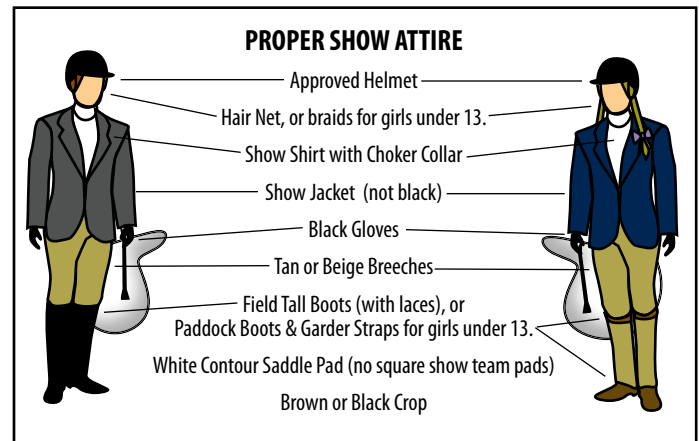

PROPER SHOW ATTIRE



RULES & INFORMATION FOR AWAY SHOWS

- Riders may only compete in classes approved by the coach, on horses approved by the coach.
- Sharing horses is encouraged, but all final decisions will be made by the coach.
- Riders **MUST** attend the 2 practices before the show they are attending. Cost of the practice is \$45. Practices may not be used in place of regular lessons or as a make-up lesson for semester students.
- Riders may share privately owned horses if approved by the coach. The decision of charging a horse use fee will be the decision of the horse's owner, and will be between the owner and rider.
- Complete proper show attire is required for away shows, including approved helmets and footwear.
- Competitors must be present throughout the entire show day and are responsible for their horse's safety and care.
- Riders may not leave the showgrounds for any reason, and must be present to load and unload their horse both at the farm and showgrounds.
- Competitors may not ride on the showgrounds without the permission of the coach, and must be supervised at all times by the coach or assistant coaches while riding.
- Transportation to and from the shows will be the responsibility of the parents or guardians.

SHOW FEES & COST

- **Trailing:** \$TBD/horse
- **Stall at Show:** \$40/horse
- **Entry Fees:** \$12/class, +\$30 office fees, per person
- **Coaching:** \$50 per person
- **EHC Horse Use Fee:** \$50 per person
- **REFUNDS** are **ONLY** available if horse or rider are sick or injured prior to leaving for the show. Refunds for trailing fees are **NON-REFUNDABLE**. Show fees may be refundable with the exception of a "scratch fee" withheld by the show secretary.
- Multiple riders sharing a horse may split the trailing and stall fees only. No other fees may be split.
- **FEES AND ENTRIES ARE DUE** to the coach 2 weeks before each show.
