Camper Programs

Riding—Beginning & Intermediate

Farm Camp

CIT Camp

This program is for youth ages 14-17 interested in a camp counselor certification and gaining experience in the fundamentals of teaching horsemanship and riding. CIT's will assist instructors in setting up lessons and coordinating educational activities, with emphasis on safety, for children's groups. Each CIT will have two supervised rides per session. Seventeen year old CIT camp graduates may receive an invitation to partake in a paid internship their next summer. Participants receive a certificate of completion. Requirement: Letter of recommendation from riding instructor
